Signage created for SSO is concerning: "monitoring and cleanup is in progress"

How is this being done since you are to be making a public statement of such actions?

As indicated in a recent addition for Severe Storms Hazard Plan, this is a PW issue

1 of the 4 generators belonging to JEMS was taken from the JEMS trailer

It was being used to power the sewer cam recently following a line back-up

This is NOT boro equipment and should not be used without JEMS permission

The JEMS trailer was moved but the front ""foot"" of it was not secured on a block

The piece of board typically placed under the foot was left along side of it

This has allowed the foot to sink into the loose dirt underneath

The diesel fuel storage tank was relocated- it is now INSIDE a garage?

This reserve of fuel for PW equipment is critical for emergency operations

Prior notification of the EMC/staff for such actions would be appreciated

Elected officials should complete FEMA online training to become familiar with EMC functionality

While recent federal shut-downs have closed the FEMA training portal, it is now available

ICS100 & ICS700 are the minimum basic introductory classes that all elected officials should complete

Students must first register for a FEMA Student ID before starting the classes
