RESOLUTION ADOPTING COMMUNITY PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of West Mayfield had deemed it necessary to establish Community Park rules and regulations to maintain proper order, protect municipal property, and to preserve health, safety, and wellbeing of all park users; and

WHEREAS, Council intends for these Community Park rules and regulations to be enforced, as necessary and permitted, by all applicable Borough ordinances and laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Council may duly amend this resolution altering these Community Park rules and regulations as it sees fit:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Council of the Borough of West Mayfield hereby adopts the following Community Park rules and regulations:

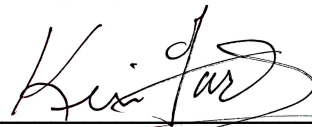
1. Park hours are from dawn to dusk.
2. All pets must be on a leash or restrained at all times.
3. All pet waste must be collected and disposed of immediately.
4. No littering. All trash must be disposed of properly in designated receptacles or removed from the park.
5. No dumping of motor oils, liquids, or other toxic fluids on Borough property.
6. No open fires or burning of any kind except in designated devices.
7. All open-fire cooking must be done on grills. Coals must be placed in designated containers for coals.
8. No fireworks.
9. Parking in designated areas only. No parking on the grass.
10. No overnight parking or vehicles left unattended overnight.
11. No nails, brads, or staples affixed to trees, tables, or benches.
12. No cutting of trees, flowers, or removal of natural material from the park.
13. No hunting, harming, or molesting of wildlife.
14. No discharge of firearms, bows, or weapons.
15. No skateboards, bikes, scooters, or rollerblades permitted on recreational courts and surfaces, ball fields, or inside shelters.
16. No motorized vehicles of any kind permitted on the grass.
17. Park shelter reservations have priority use.
18. No illegal, illicit, profane, or vulgar activities.
